CODE OF CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

1. It's mandatory that every student must wear only the **Prescribed School Uniform** identity card at school and while travelling.
2. On special occasion students ought to be attired in simple is decent way should be aligned to the norms of the school dress, hairstyle, behaviors, habits etc.
3. He / She should conduct himself / her self.
4. Students shall greet each other and their teachers with traditional 'Namaste'. Their behaviour towards elders shall be marked by respect and obedience.
5. Students are advised to keep their classroom, school building and campus neat & clean and throw leftovers into the dustbins. Books are to be maintained neatly. A student causing any such damage will be liable for penalty together with cost of damages decided by the authorities.
6. The use of **plastic disposals/polythene bags** is to be avoided.
7. Students indulging in malpractice during examination will face disciplinary action as decided by the school authorities.
8. Students are to adhere strictly to the rules and regulations of the school, failing which, they are liable for suspension.
9. **Late comers will be marked absent for that particular day.**
10. Parents are informed to collect their ward **within 15 minutes** from the closing time of the school.
11. Students are prohibited from carrying valuables, any book, newspaper, magazine or any other publications considered to be harmful, expensive watches, walkman, mobile phone etc to the school.
On Violation of this, the articles will be confiscated.
12. Visitors, Parents or guardians will not be allowed to communicate with any student during class hours without the written permission from the Principal.

STUDENTS ADMISSION – TERMS AND CONDITIONS :

Date :

- 1) Both parents of the student should appear for interaction at the school campus for an interaction with the academic team. In case, any of the parents is unable to come to the interaction on the day fixed, then a 'No Objection Certificate' by the absentee parent should be submitted to the school – stating that the absentee parent has gone through the rules and regulations and they have 'No Objection' to their child joining RVK in the event of the child being granted admission.
- 2) In case of a single parent –
 - If one/both the parents of the student has expired, an attested copy of the Death Certificate has to be submitted along with the student's Registration form.
 - If the parent is a divorcee, the relevant legal document regarding the guardianship of the child, visiting rights of the parent - must be submitted along with the student's Registration form.
- 3) It is mandatory for all parents to attend the Orientation Programme with RVK - conducted in the school campus on the fixed date.
- 4) Admission to RVK school is based on merit i.e performance of the student in the oral and the written round of the aptitude test – irrespective of his/her caste, creed or community. The school does not accept any recommendations for grant of admissions.
- 5) The school Registration fee and 1st installment of the Annual School fee has to be paid to the school – within the stipulated time (as mentioned at the time of Registration), failing which the admission would be offered to the student who is next in the order of merit.
- 6) Once the fees is paid, the student is provisionally admitted to the school and admission of the student to RVK school will be complete only after the parent submit – the 'Original Transfer Certificate' of the child issued by the previous school on or before the joining of the school.
- 7) If the Transfer Certificate is not submitted at the time of joining RVK, the provisional admission granted to the student by RVK will stand cancelled and under such circumstances, the fee already paid by the parents/guardians would not be refunded by the school to the parents.
- 8) If the selected student fails to join RVK school for whatever reasons, after paying the admission fee and 1st installment of school fee, the fee already paid to the school – will not be refunded to the parent – the same fee is not transferable to any other student and the un-availed admission does not hold good for the successive academic year/years.

Rule Governing Remittance of School Fee by Parents

- 1) Mode of payment – all fees to the school should be paid only through "EDUMERGE" for Parent payment gateway.
- 2) Parent can generate the receipt.
- 3) Any student's fees under any category – once paid to the school cannot be refunded to the parents/student under any circumstances (even if the student does not attend the school for a single day).
- 4) The due dates for two installments for the Annual School Fee are 30th April and 30th September of every year.
- 5) Failure to pay any of the two installments of the Annual School Fee – before the respective pay – by dates – attracts late payment fee / per day commencing from the very next day after the 'pay – by - date'.
- 6) After the lapse of one month from the 'pay – by - date', if an installment of a student's Annual School Fee is still unpaid to the school, and then admission of the student will be automatically terminated – without giving any notice to the parent.
- 7) The total school fee is subject to yearly review and an annual increase to 10% or below is customary every academic year.

- 8) The school will not accept any part payment of any installment – whatever be the reason.
- 9) **Short message services (SMS) from school** - the school regularly sends messages and reminders to all parents. Parents are therefore advised to :
- Regularly check their mobile phone in-box SMSs through "EDUMERGE" for Parent from school. In case you do not receive any message from school for more than a week, immediately enquire with the school about the same. Parents should mention the phone number/update phone number as and when required to which all important information and notification from the school should be sent.
 - Note that in view of the above instructions, the school would not entertain parents claiming that they have not received messages or fee reminders from the school.

School Uniforms – School issues uniforms and shoes. Facilitator will be identified by the school, it is a responsibility of the parents to procure uniforms, shoes. Details can be collected from the school at the time of Registration / Admission. Parents are free to procure from any seller but uniforms should be the school prescribed uniform only.

Rule Governing – withdrawal of student from RVK School

1) Withdrawal of a child by the Parent/Guardian :

- Parents / Guardians who intended to withdraw their child / ward from the school should apply for Transfer Certificate before 28th of February.
- Transfer Certificate will not be issued to student's withdrawn after completion of Class IX as the student is registered for Class X Board Examination with the respective Examination Board.
- The application for the Transfer Certificate should be made in the Form prescribed by the school by a Parent or the authorized Guardian of the pupil.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued to those students whose school fees and dues has been fully paid for the academic year in which the transfer certificate is sought.
- Application for Transfer Certificate will not be accepted after February 28th of the academic year. Parents who apply for a Transfer Certificate after 28th February are liable to pay the complete Annual School Fee for the ensuing academic year.
- Note: However the fees not paid by 30th April, of the beginning of the any academic year the admission of the student will be automatically terminated.
- Once a student has taken Transfer Certificate and withdrawn from RVK School, if the parent wants to again admit the student back into RVK, the admission will be considered as a fresh admission and the parent has to pay a fresh Registration Fee along with Annual School Fee – on par with a fresh admission.
- Mutual Transfer among RVK School is not allowed.

Termination of students admission by RVK School

- RVK School administration team reserves the absolute right at their discretion to issue transfer certificate to any pupil :
- If
- a) School administration team is not satisfied with the general conduct of the parents/students in terms of discipline, moral and decent behavior or for instigating other students against the school systems and values.
 - b) If the Parents/Guardians fail to pay the second installment of the Annual School Fee by pay – by date, the admission of the student is liable to be terminated by the school, without giving any notice to the Parent / Guardian regarding the same.
 - c) At the end of an academic year, if Parents/Guardian fails to pay the first installment of Annual School Fee for the promoted class for the ensuing academic year – "by the pay by the due date – the admission would be automatically terminated and school would issue transfer certificate and mail the same by register post to the Parents / Guardian of the student. The school is not responsible if the Parent / Guardian do not receive or accept the registered post.

- d) If it is discovered at a later date, that any of the information furnished by the Parent / Guardian in the Registration Form & the medical history sheet – at the time of admission – is false, the School Management has the right to cancel the admission of the student.
- e) In matter of admission and issue of "Transfer Certificate", the decision of the school administration team is final and binding on the Parents/Guardian of the student concerned.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Rules for Parents:

- 1) All students are expected to wear the **prescribed school uniform only**.
- 2) After a new student is admitted into the school, RVK authorities will issue a student photo Identity card / student admission card to the Parent /Guardian of the student. Parent should carry identity card / admission card while visiting the school and produce the same at the security as a proof of identity.
- 3) Any person, other than the parents, desirous of meeting a student on the school campus should also have the identity card / admission card or an authorization letter from the parents to the school authorities, to meet the child.

Note: Persons, who are not carrying photo ID card or a valid authorization either from the school or from the parents, will not be allowed into the school campus by the security to meet the child.

- 4) Parents and visitors should adhere to the dress code of RVK, while visiting the campus i.e. Women and girls either sarees or salwar suits, Men should avoid informal wear such as shorts or sports uniform. Persons not adhering to the dress code will not be permitted in the campus.
- 5) Parents during their visit to the school have to adhere to the security rules and regulations. All the visitors should sign in the visitors register at the security and carry a visitor slip which should be presented at the security gate at the time of leaving the campus.

Note : Visitors will not be allowed to leave the campus unless visitors slip (signed by the concerned authority) is presented at the security.

- 6) Parents visiting the school on any working day – with prior permission, should first contact the school office immediately upon reaching the campus, without fail. Parents / Visitors found moving around on the campus without permission and without a visitor badge - would be asked to leave the campus immediately.
- 7) The RVK Management maintains a serene atmosphere and encourages refined behavior on the school campus and expects the same from parents and visitors. Any behavior of parents or their accomplices which sets a bad example for the students on the campus shall be viewed seriously by the School Management and that may even lead to the termination of admission of the students.
- 8) The school authorities encourage the parents to approach them directly for all queries and problems. Intermediaries / Interlocutors are strictly discouraged, unless the person is a local guardian authorized by the parents in the School Admission Form.
- 9) Parent should also note that the school is no way concerned with the personal issues between the parents. The single parent / guardian of the child should note that the admission is granted only after obtaining the consent of both the parents and the school is no way responsible for any personal issues which arise there after. Disciplinary issues between the students to be sorted out by the school authorities and the parents of the students - in – conflict or to limit themselves to bringing any issues to the notice of the Principal / Management. Parents should not use the school premises to settle their personal scores and openly discuss personal issues.
- 10) The application of admission to RVK elicits all types of information about the student – which is provided by the students' parents / guardians under oath.

Any deliberate attempt to withhold information or furnishing of false information by the parent/guardian is a serious offence under law. Strict action may be initiated under such circumstance, including the termination of the admission of the child. Single parents should furnish legal documents regarding guardianship of the child and visiting rights granted by the Court. Any change, in address and telephone numbers of the parents/guardians of the child should be immediately notified to the school authorities, in writing by the parents and an acknowledgement should be obtained by the school official as to how such information is furnished.

- 11) Student and parents are responsible for the cleanliness of the area where they are seated and the area should not be littered. Trash bins must be used effectively. The school is a "No Plastic Zone" and the use of polythene and other plastic material is strictly prohibited in the campus.
- 12) All the parents are required to attend every Parent - Teacher Interaction. It is mandatory for the parents to attend sessions conducted on the days of Parent Teacher interaction and all other school functions, in the best interest of the child's development. During the Parent Teacher interaction, the parents are required to ask Teachers queries related to the academic performance of the child. Teachers are not responsible for administration related issues. For any administrative related queries parents are to approach the Principal only.
- 13) **Birth day celebrations:** Birth day will be celebrated in a unique way. Parents are informed in advance with the details to attend the same and are expected to wear "Bharatiya" dress and to distribute homemade sweets in conforming with Bharatiya tradition.
- 14) All parental correspondence to the school authorities shall be cordial.
- 15) **During the school programmes :**
 - Parents should not interfere with the internal affairs of the school curriculum regarding any events, programmes and competitions or even discourage students from holding any post in the Student Council.
 - Parents are not allowed to leave the campus till the programme is over.
 - In case if the parents have any genuine problem and want to leave early the security slip should be counter signed by either the Principal / Co-ordinators.
- 16) It is prerogative of RVK management to recruit or terminate any teaching or non-teaching staff, interference of any nature from any quarters will not be entertained.
- 17) The school management reserves the right to cancel or modify any of the rules and regulations and formulate new rules from time to time, which will be duly notified to all the parents.

Leaves and Exit of students

- The school reserves the right to deny permission for an exit to a student during important occasion in the academic session, such as school programmes, examination etc. In case of wedding, a student will be permitted if his/her brother or sister getting married. For this purpose the parent has to produce the wedding card. Parents are required to plan their family vacation in accordance with the school vacation enlisted in the school calendar of events.
- In case a student makes an exit on emergency medical grounds during the academic session, parents have to produce the medical report. A plain certificate on a Doctor's letter head will not be treated as a report and parents need to either produce evidence of hospitalization or pathological medical report.
- Parents / Guardians taking their child on exit, should sign in the prescribe ' exit book ' at the school office and collect an exit slip that needs to be submitted at the school security at the exit gate, before taking child out of the campus. The security will not permit any student to leave the campus without the exit slip issued by the office.
